L. DOES THE CASINO ORGANISE INTRODUCTIONS TO TABLE GAMES?

Table game introductory sessions are organised by some of our casinos so that you may discover and familiarise yourself with this legendary world. To find out more about the dates and times of these sessions, consult your casino's website.

2. DO THE CASINOS BARRIÈRE ORGANISE POKER TOURNAMENTS?

The casinos offer local tournaments, the Barrière Poker Tournament. The find out more, go to BARRIÈRE POKER.

3. DOES THE CASINO OFFER TEXAS HOLD'EM?

The majority of Casinos Barrière offer Texas Hold'em Poker as a cash game. Visit your casino's website to find out dates and times.

4- WHAT HAPPENS IF I WIN A LARGE JACKPOT?

2 options are available to you: you may request your winnings to be paid by cheque from the casino or request to be paid in cash.

Note: for winnings over $\{1,500\}$ the player must pay the CSG (French social security contribution, 12% of winnings) and show their ID.

5. WHEN I PRESENT MY ID, ARE MY CONTACT DETAILS SAVED?

The only aim of the procedure in place at the entrance of our casinos is to verify that you are of the age of majority and that you are not 'prohibited from gambling'... No information relating to your identity is stored.

L. SLOT MACHINE WINNINGS ARE NOT TAXABLE.

This is true, but... For winnings over €1,500, the player must pay the CSG (French social security contribution) and show their ID. Make sure you always have it with you...

7. I ONLY WISH TO GO TO THE CASINO BAR, DO I NEED TO SHOW ID?

Yes... if the bar is located within the casino. Since I November 2006, the presentation of valid ID is required at the entrance of all areas of French casinos in order to protect minors and those 'prohibited from gambling'. If the casino bar has a direct and/or separate entrance, the presentation of ID will not be required.

B. SLOT MACHINES ARE USED TO LAUNDER DIRTY MONEY.

Any movement of money of €2,000 or above is recorded with the French Sub-Directorate of Gaming and Casinos.

9. IN THE GAMES ROOM, CAN I SIMPLY WATCH?

There is absolutely no obligation for you to play! Whether to accompany a group of friends or to simply familiarise yourself with the rules, you may of course watch the various games. And if you want to have a go, please know that introductory sessions are organised in some of our casinos.

L□. CAN I BRING MY CHILDREN TO THE CASINO RESTAURANT?

Yes, but... Minors may only access the casino restaurant if the gaming areas are out of site (direct entrance, separate area).

THE CASINO CAN CHANGE THE PAYOUT PERCENTAGE OF SLOT MACHINE WINNINGS.

The Casino does not have access to the part of the slot machines that changes the payout. So that puts an end to that.
